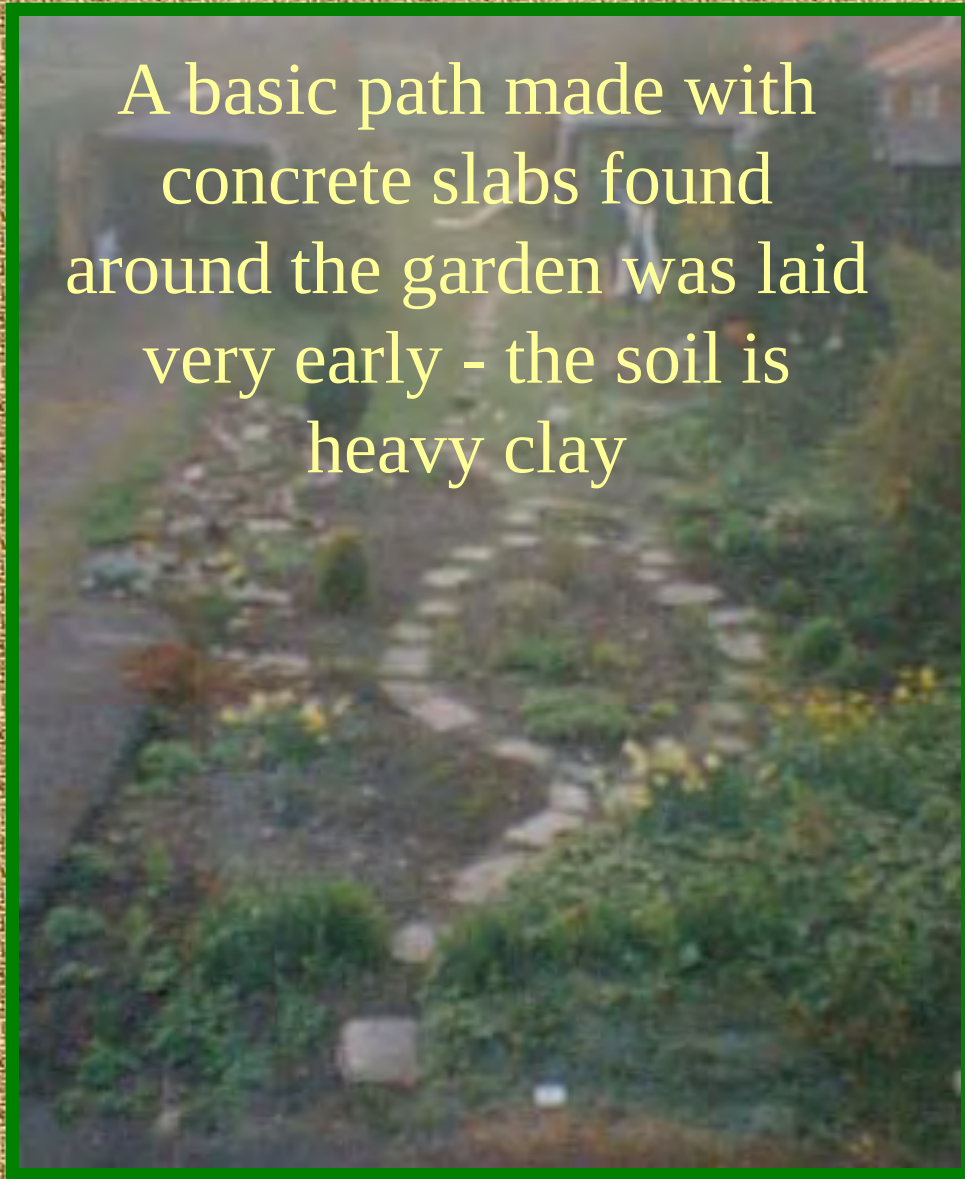




PATHS
